

Windows Technical Requirements

Requirements for All Platforms

- The teacher and all the students in the class must use the same device type platform (IOS or Windows or Chromebook).
- Starting the school year on one platform and then moving to a different platform is not supported and will cause the app to malfunction.

Disk Requirements

Required: 1.5 GB per user for the Pearson System of Courses app and user-generated content (UGC), plus content storage on the device as per below (size in gigabytes).

Note: Size of UGC can vary based on types of user-generated content. Video content will require more space on the device. Storage for this content can vary based on the number of users per device and should be planned and calculated as needed.
