

## iOS Technical Requirements

Based on current hardware and software technologies, Pearson has determined the technical requirements listed in this document will deliver acceptable operation and performance for Pearson System of Courses on an iPad.

Your actual performance may vary due to the following:

- Available network bandwidth
- Number of concurrent users
- Other variables

The suitability of your specific computing environment needs to be re-evaluated whenever there are changes made to the school or district environment.

These specifications are intended strictly as a guideline. They were developed in an environment free from network congestion, resource contention, and aggressive security measures.

Consider the minimum requirements applicable only if your device uses a minimally configured and supported operating system with only this Pearson application installed on the device.

## Requirements for All Platforms

- The teacher and all of the students in a class must use the same device type platform (iOS or Windows or Chromebook).
- Starting the school year on one platform and then moving to a different platform is not supported and will cause the app to malfunction.

Other Requirements	<ul> <li>Ability to install an app from the app store either using a mobile device management (MDM) solution, manual installation, or sideload method</li> <li>User authentication requires school district Active Directory integration or Pearson System of Courses authentication process with district-provided usernames and passwords</li> </ul>



## Disk Requirements

**Required:** 1.5 GB per user for the Pearson System of Courses app and user-generated content (UGC), plus content storage on the device as per below (size in gigabytes).

**Note:** Size of UGC can vary based on types of user-generated content. Video content will require more space on the device. Storage for this content can vary based on the number of users per device and should be planned and calculated as needed.
